
PHONICS AND WORD STUDY

You may be aware that the minister for education has mandated the introduction of Systematic Synthetic Phonics for students from foundation to year two and Word Study for students in years three to six by 2027. This term, teachers at Heatherhill Primary School have worked collaboratively with educational consultant Anny Lawrence to align their classroom practice with the government's mandate. Although phonics and word study have always been part of teaching and learning at Heatherhill Primary School, the mandate has invited us to reflect on our practice and make adjustments to meet the government's expectations.

SunSmart SCHOOLS – STUDENT WEARING OF HATS

Heatherhill Primary School is a SunSmart School. From <u>September 1</u> to <u>May 29</u>, all students must wear a sun-protective hat that shades the face, neck and ears for all outdoor activities.

- Students wear a broad-brimmed or bucket hat school hat to protect their face, head, neck and ears when outdoors.
- Baseball or peaked caps and sun visors are not considered a suitable alternative, as they do not protect the ears, cheeks or neck.
- Students not wearing appropriate school uniform or hat will be asked to sit in our designated area under the oak tree to protect them from the sun.
